GemsTracker (GEneric Medical Survey Tracker) is a software package for (complex) distribution of questionnaires and forms during clinical research and quality registrations in healthcare. The software allows you to set up your own website for data collection. On a GemsTracker site different users, are able to submit, view and sent information. GemsTracker offers:


- Extensive patient/ respondent management
